Every student at Temecula Valley High School must complete volunteer work as part of his/her graduation requirements: **Class of 2012: 30 hours and 40 community service hours beginning with the class of 2013.**

Students must:

- a) perform work for a **non-profit organization**;
- b) complete the work for neither money nor credit;
- c) list hours worked on a **daily basis** as performed (do not log as total sum of hours worked over an extended period of time);
- d) have the adult that supervised you sign for the work you completed **each day**;
- e) signature must **NOT** come from your parent;
- f) perform work outside of regular school hours;
- g) submit this **completed** form to the **CAREER CENTER** in Building 4.

Please note: When "TOTAL HOURS" include a partial hour, it will be converted to the lower full hour. i.e., 10 ½ hours will record as 10 hours.
